Title: Student Publications

Rule 7.38

Effective Date: October 23, 2002

Purpose: To state College policy regarding student publications.

Student Publication Defined

A student publication is any written publication produced by students through College sponsorship, and is either partially or fully funded by the College.

Administration

Any student publication must be monitored by the faculty/staff advisor or advisors to the student group or student that produces the publication. It is the responsibility of the faculty/staff advisor or advisors to ensure that the proposed publication is edited and produced in accordance with the statement of philosophy for the publication and in accordance with College rules, policies, and regulations prior to the publication or other distribution.
